A Tip Sheet for THE WIZ JR. Sensory Friendly Performance **Wednesday, April 6 at 1 PM at the Taft Theatre**

We understand that other Cincinnati arts organizations have recently changed their health & safety rules. However, to protect our youngest patrons that attend our shows, we have decided to keep our requirements in place for all performances of this production:

- Masks are required inside the theater for ALL ticketholders over the age of 2, regardless of vaccination status.
- Proof of full vaccination OR a negative COVID test administered by a health care provider OR proof of natural immunity are required for ALL ticketholders over the age of 12.
- We appreciate your cooperation and kindness towards others.

Additional Tips:

- The **doors to the Taft Theatre will open at 12:00 PM**. The sensory-friendly **performance will start at 1 PM** and will last for approximately **60 minutes**.

- Audience members will not receive tickets for this performance. Instead, please check in at the front of the theater. **Seating is not assigned except for larger groups**. The ushers inside the theater will guide you to your seat.
- You may want to **bring something to do while you are waiting in your seat for the performance to begin** (social narrative, preferred fidgets, books, handheld electronic devices, etc.).
- During the performance, the **lights** will remain at **30 percent brightness**. The **sound level** will be **reduced** for loud or startling sounds.
- You are welcome to **enter and exit the theater as needed** during the sensory-friendly performance. You are permitted to bring fidgets, handheld devices, and noise-cancelling headphones.
- There are **3 restrooms** located off the lobby – to the left as you exit the theater. The toilets flush by hand and there are paper towels available to dry hands.
- For this performance there will be one **quiet area located down a hallway on the side of the lobby**. Volunteers will be available to assist guests with locating the quiet area.
- **Food and drinks will be not sold** at this performance. Families are permitted to bring appropriate snacks and drinks from home but eating and drinking **is discouraged** in the theater during this performance due to mask-wearing.
- **Photography and videotaping is NOT** permitted inside the theater.
